

Ascential Alternative Data DDQ

GENERAL

1. **Please provide a brief description of the company, types of data, and services provided.** *Ascential provides data to help the world's largest brands/retailers build, market, and sell their products across the digital economy. Ascential Alternative Data provides to the buy side the same datasets used by the brands/retailer.*
2. **Briefly describe your current customer base (e.g., corporates, investment managers, hedge funds).** *Our customer base includes corporates, investment managers, hedge funds, and private equity funds.*
3. **Do you collect data with respect to natural persons in the U.S. or the E.U.? If yes to E.U., do you have a policy to ensure compliance with the GDPR?** *No.*
4. **What steps have you taken to confirm that you are legally permitted to collect, store, and sell the data?** *Over 80% of the retailer websites we scrape are also paying clients of Ascential and have given permission to collection this information.*
5. **Do you enter into written contracts with 3rd parties that contain provisions that govern your ability to sell data?** *No.*
6. **Are there any data usage restrictions we should be aware of?** *Internal use only.*
7. **Have there been any legal proceedings against you with respect to the use of this data?** *No.*
8. **Provide a brief overview of your internal policies with respect to data privacy, PII and MNPI.** *The scraping process is designed to only capture data points related to product ID, product description, brand name, price, promotional markdown and stock status. The scraper only collects publicly*

available data and does not go behind logins. This precludes collecting MNPI or PII.

DATA COLLECTION

9. **Please provide an overview of how the data is obtained.** *The data is collected via daily web scraping. Once collected we process the data using our industry specific taxonomies to classify each SKU/product in a sub-category and category structure. Each SKU / Product is mapped to a brand and retailer name, which are mapped to a Bloomberg ticker ID.*
10. **Do you conceal or mask your scraper identity?** *No. We always lead with IP address that identify us as Ascential / WGSN. There may be some cases where we use proxies to efficiently scrape a larger site, but it is not used to mask/conceal our identity.*
11. **Is the data owner aware that you are collecting data?** *Yes.*
12. **Is the data obtained from public sources? If so, what are those sources and methods of collection?** *Yes, we only collect publicly available information via web scraping.*
13. **Is the data obtained from private sources?** *No.*
14. **Do you have any "quality control" policies or procedures in place to ensure accuracy of data before providing your data product?** *We have systematic audits in place to identify any issues with the data collection process. We will communicate with clients about potential fixes or expected downtime.*
